## **Fabric Requirements for Project:**


Background Fabric - 1/2 yard  
Top Band - 1/4 yard

## **Optional Supplies:**

Marking Pencil or Pen  
Pins  
Iron

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# Decorate Your Own - Stocking - Project Pattern

**Finished Project Size:** 13" x 18"

**Fabric Requirements for Project:**

Background Fabric - ½ yard  
 Top Band - ¼ yard

**Optional Supplies:**

Marking Pencil or Pen  
 Pins  
 Iron

**Cutting Instructions:**

1. From the fabric selected for the top band of the stocking, cut 1 piece 8.5" x 18". Set aside.
2. From the background fabric, carefully cut out the stocking shape using the placement sheets provided on pages #2 through #5 . Set aside.

NOTE: *Cutting the stocking shape is easier if you lay the assembled placement sheet down on the table. Place background fabric on placement sheet and trace the outline of stocking*


**Construction:**

- ¼" seam allowances are used in construction of the project.
1. Place stocking pieces right sides together. Sew around the perimeter of the stocking, using a ¼ seam allowance, leaving the top edge unsewn. Flip the stocking right side out.
  2. Sew the short sides of the stocking band, right sides together to form a tube.
  3. Fold the tube in half to create a tube half the width, with a fold on one edge and both raw edges on the other edge.
  4. Slide the tube inside the stocking matching the raw edges. Pin in several places. Sew the band in place.
  5. Flip band over to the right side of the stocking. Press seam flat.

**Placement Sheet Instructions:**

Use pages #2 through #5 to assemble the placement sheet:


1. Cut the sheets on the dotted ( . . . ) lines.
2. Tape section #1 to section #2, making sure that the motifs align exactly.
3. Tape the remaining sections together into pairs as illustrated. Again, make sure that all the motifs align exactly.
4. Tape the #1/#2 section pairs to the #3/#4 section pairs together in the same way as above until placement sheet is complete. Make sure that the motifs align exactly.







