



Two Page Self-Print Instructions - Horizontal Layout

1. Print as many page #1's and page #2's that are needed to achieve the pantograph length you want.
2. Cut along the dotted line of one of the page #2's. Repeat the process for all page #2's that were printed.
3. Overlap one page #2 on top of page #1, making sure to line up the design. Permanently tape or glue in place. Repeat the process for all page #1's and #2's that were printed.




4. Overlap one page #1/#2 set (assembled in the previous step) on top of another, making sure to line up the design. Permanently tape or glue in place. Repeat the process for all page #1/#2 sets that were printed.



NOTE: The process will be the same whether the design is printed as portrait or landscape.

Two Page Self-Print Instructions - Vertical Layout

1. Print as many page #1's and page #2's that are needed to achieve the pantograph length you want.
2. Cut along the dotted line of one of the page #2's. Repeat the process for all page #2's that were printed.
3. Overlap one page #2 on top of page #1, making sure to line up the design. Permanently tape or glue in place. Repeat the process for all page #1's and #2's that were printed.



4. Overlap one page #1/#2 set (assembled in the previous step) on top of another, making sure to line up the design. Permanently tape or glue in place. Repeat the process for all page #1/#2 sets that were printed.
