Includes sizes to fit: 8", 10" and 12" blocks

Fabric Requirements for Appliqué:

One set - Appliqué Elementz Laser-Cut Fusible Appliqué
Red, White and Blue - Small UEA-1105

Or the following:

For each size or variation, one Fat Eighth or Large Scrap of:

Five shades or patterns of red polka dots
Two shades or patterns of blue polka dots
Orange polka dot

Optional Supplies:

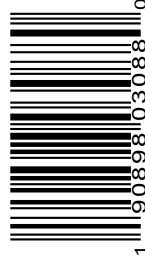
Fusible Web
Light Box
Marking Pencil or Pen
Pins
Iron

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Basic Instructions for Appliqué:

NOTE: If using Appliqué Elementz Laser-Cut Fusible Appliqué, proceed to step #5 of appliqué instructions.

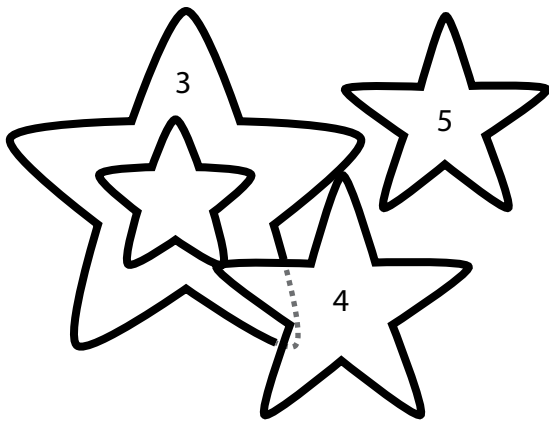
If not using fusible web:

1. Using the placement sheets cut out the marked motifs. Prepare them as needed for your preferred method of appliqué. NOTE: Remember to add a seam allowance if needed.
2. Lay each block placement sheet down on table. Place your project (fabric, t-shirt, glass, etc.) exactly on the placement sheet, and pin (if possible) in several places around the edge.
3. Position the appliqué pieces on your project, matching the edges of the appliqué pieces to the outlines of the motifs on the placement sheets.
4. When pleased with the arrangement, permanently adhere or stitch down appliqué using your preferred method.

If using fusible web:

1. Trace the motifs onto the paper side of fusible web, reversing the images as needed.
2. Cut out the appliqué pieces, leaving about ¼" of web outside the drawn line if needed.
3. Press the fusible web pieces onto the wrong side of the fabric following the manufacturer's instructions.
4. Cut out the appliqué pieces neatly on the lines.
5. Lay each placement sheet down on table. Place your project exactly on top of each placement sheet, and pin (if possible) in several places around the edge.
6. Peel off the paper backing and position the appliqué pieces (webbing side down) on your project, matching the edges of the appliqué pieces to the outlines of the motifs on the placement sheets.
7. When pleased with the arrangement, fuse the appliqué in place following the manufacturer's instructions.





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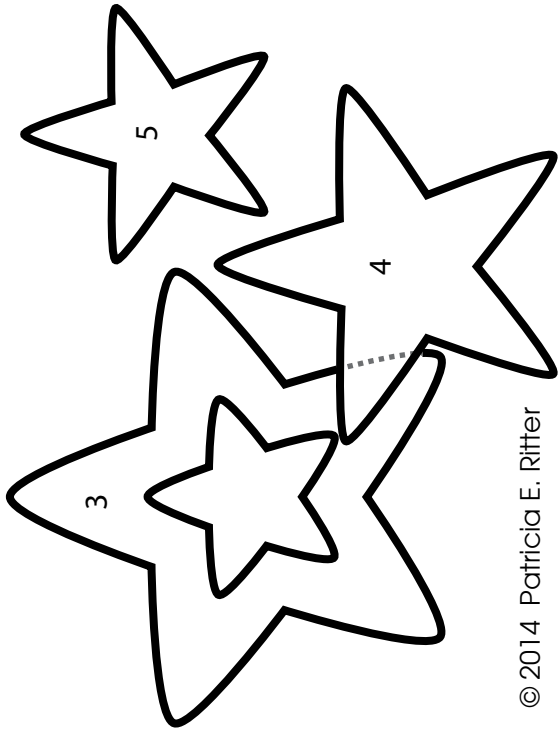
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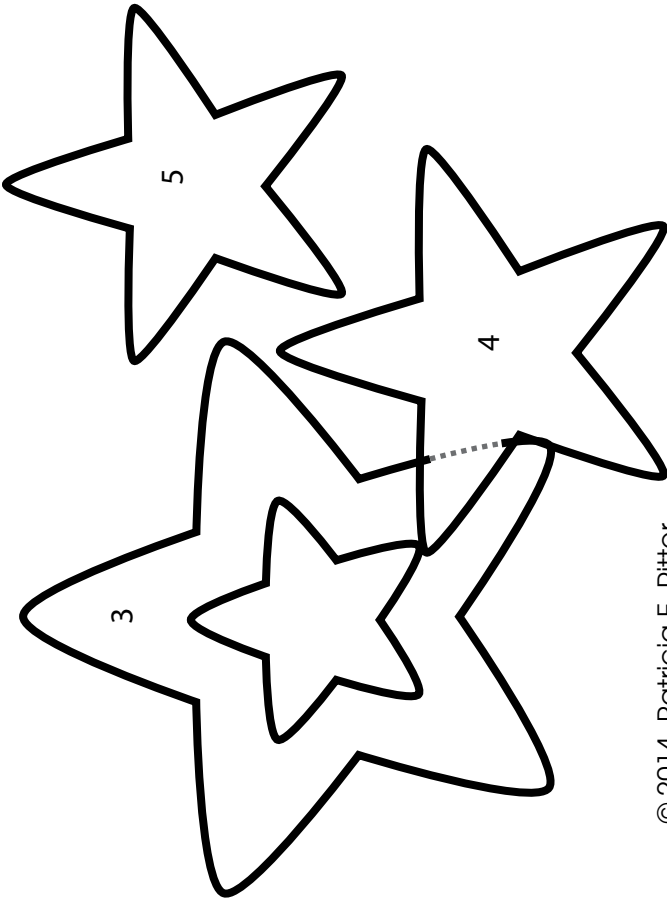
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
